## Procedures for Remote Learning/Teaching for USD Quarantined Students

Only students who are quarantined by the USD Nurse will be eligible for synchronous remote learning. (Please reference the flowchart on the USD website under Covid19 Related Information)

Exception - if an entire school or grade-level is on remote learning

**Attendance** – students who are on quarantine will be marked with a <u>C19 code</u> and not marked as present even if participating through synchronous remote learning (does not count toward parent excuses nor does it count against perfect attendance)

## **Procedures for Teachers:**

- 1. Share a link for only quarantined students who are in your class to participate (please remain current with the shared quarantine list)
- 2. A maximum of (5) five days will be given upon a student's return from quarantine to make up tests, quizzes, labs, etc.
- 3. Testing will not be permitted through remote learning and shall be made up upon return to in-person learning
- 4. Students are expected to log into your course on time, have on their camera, and be fully participating (Do not spend excessive amounts of time attempting to get remote learners to engage in the class which may detract from the effectiveness of instruction. They are expected to engage and participate as if they were seated in your class.)

Grades K-2 shall continue to provide asynchronous learning for students on quarantine
