PARENT/STUDENT AGREEMENT For Attending Dual Enrollment Courses on Campus

- 1. Student Responsibilities: Students must act on their own behalf. Parents, guardians, relatives or friends of Union School District (USD) students are not permitted to enroll, drop, or add classes on behalf of the student. The same applies to requesting transcripts or grade verifications.
- 2. Contacting Instructors: Your student is enrolled in a college course and it is important to understand that instructors work directly with students, as opposed to the type of parent interventions you may be accustomed to at the high school level. Under FERPA (Family Educational Rights and Privacy Act) instructors are not required to discuss student performance or other student-related issues with parents.

USD does not accommodate parent requests to contact instructors.

- 3. Course Content/ Material: A college campus is an adult learning environment. As such, discussion topics and course materials are generally designed for adult students and may not be appropriate for younger students.
- 4. USD assumes no responsibility for the supervision of minor students outside of the classroom setting.

Parents are responsible for providing transportation and ensuring that their children are appropriately supervised before and after class.

- 5. By Attending Dual Enrollment Courses on Clarion University of Pennsylvania Clarion Campus, students may not be able to take USD courses due to scheduling conflicts, such as band, chorus, etc.
- 6. When students do not have college classroom courses, they should report to USD premises unless given written permission by administration. Permission may be granted for research classwork, study groups, etc.
